This workshop will present a brief discussion of Dissociative Identity Disorder, from the perspective of causes, manifestations, and working with DID clients using Christ-centred healing approaches. Case examples will be provided, as well as successful and less successful interventions. Reference to clients with suspected satanic ritual abuse will also be made.

This workshop is more about exploring how to work with these clients, rather than presumption of expertise, recognizing the difficulties inherent in working with this client population. Emphasis will be placed on participants sharing their own experiences (if any) with such clients, and mutual information sharing for the benefit of therapist and client alike.
