

Using a Support Group Curriculum in Healing Childhood Sexual Abuse Trauma with Theophostic Prayer (9/12)

The presenters will provide an overview of a 10-part DVD series *–In the Wildflowers–* with an accompanying curriculum for those who wish to facilitate a support group for women who have experienced the pain of childhood sexual abuse. An introduction to Theophostic prayer will be included. A demonstration video using Theophostic prayer with Dr. Ed Smith (founder of Theophostic Prayer Ministry) and Julie Woodley will show how this prayer brings healing to the painful areas of childhood sexual abuse.
