Fr Robert Faricy

Fr Faricy is a Jesuit priest and Theologian who is an Emeritus Professor of Spirituality of the Pontifical University in Rome. He is presently living at Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Fr Faricy has written over 30 books most translated into several languages and several hundred articles. He frequently ministers in healing in Italy, the U.S., Mexico and other countries, speaking at conventions and retreats.

Francois Paradis, OML B.A. (Th) M.A. (Mission Studies)

Fr Francois, was ordained in 1972. His entire ministry has been with the Ojibwa First Nations communities in Southern Manitoba. He has also been involved in inter-religious dialogue with the First Nations spirituality. He is presently pastor of Kateri Tekakwitha Aboriginal Catholic parish in Winnipeg, Manitoba. He has just been certified as part of a team to deliver the "Returning to Spirit: Residential Schools, Healing and Reconciliation Workshop, in English and French. Later this year it will become his full time ministry.

Dr Daniel Klassen, PhD.

Dr Klassen is Professor Emeritus in Education at Lakehead University. He is the founding therapist and a practicing counselor at the Listening Centre which is a clinic serving individuals of North Western Ontario, who have personal, family, or work challenges. He is the author of the Forgiveness Work book which was written for those who want to forgive but do not know how. Daniel is the 9th of 11 children in a family of Mennonite heritage and presently serves as Elder at Lakehead Baptist Church which belongs to the General Conference of Baptist Churches of Canada. He lives with his wife in Thunder Bay. Together they have 3 children and eight grandchildren.

Frances Huebel

Frances has been an ACT member for over 10 years. She was raised Roman Catholic and been blessed to have known and been taught by a series of lay Christians and priests who were involved with healing, generational healing and evangelization. 3 years ago she completed the Elijah School of Prayer counseling (Sanford's) and has also attended the School of Healing (McNutt's) where her word gifts and discernment had an opportunity to grow. She is pursuing a degree at York University in Toronto, majoring in Psychology.

Cheryl Nguyen

Cheryl is a consecrated person with three vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. Previous to consecrating her life to God she was a project engineer in the field of design products and optical equipment in the media industry. She now dedicates her time to the Lord. She will be ministering to us together with Fr Faricy.

Pasquale Fiorino PhD

Pasquale is currently the Regional Co-ordinator for Windsor/Essex deaneries in the Diocese of London, Ontario. He holds a PhD in Church History and is a part time professor at Iona College, University of Windsor. He has also taught at Marygrove College and St. Cyril and Methodius Seminary, in Detroit, Mich. He has produced and directed several historical documentaries for which he has won international awards.
