

ACTheals Steps for the Mentor Program

Mentors: Our program provides opportunities for seasoned practitioners to mentor new members by sharing their time and expertise, along with assisting them to participate in an introductory Training Program.

Please pray and ask God if he is calling you to be a mentor.

If you are interested:

1. Fill out the application and submit it online or send it to the Program Director (currently, George Guschwan by email at gguschwan5@gmail.com or by mail to 4201 Tuckerman St. University Park, MD 20782).
2. Within two weeks the program director will get back to you and let you know if there is a person in need of a Mentor.
3. If so, you will receive the name of a person desiring mentoring (Mentee) and their phone number and email (if possible from the same Specialty Group).
4. The Mentor will contact the Mentee to set up their initial meeting to determine if both want to work with each other (pray and discern).
5. If they think it is a good match, the Mentor will contact the Program Director to set up a meeting of all three. At that meeting, a plan for mentoring will be drafted (goals). Mentor and Mentee will sign and date the plan. The plan will be in place for 1 year. If either party needs to terminate earlier, they should call to inform the Director who will set up a final meeting.
6. After 6 months, the Mentor will call the Director for a meeting to discuss progress toward the goals. Both Mentor and Mentee can contact the Director about concerns at any time.
7. After 1 year, the Mentor will call the Program Director for a final meeting. At this time, the Mentor and Mentee will determine if they want to continue their mentoring relationship on their own.
